

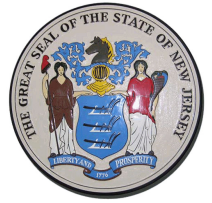

### Spotted Lanternfly's

Due to the high number of Spotted Lanternfly complaints, the Registered Environmental Health Specialist of the Hasbrouck Heights Board of Health has been conducting on site investigations and providing educational information in person and via mail to inform residents and businesses how to control/reduce the Spotted Lanternfly population, as well as remove invasive host plants, such as the Tree of Heaven, when necessary.
